


POLICY

The <u>Juvenile Law Center</u> has released a new report, Rethinking Justice for Emerging Adults, which highlights developmentally appropriate responses to emerging adults at risk of justice system involvement. Though the report focuses on opportunities for reform in the Great Lakes region, it may be of interest to Maine stakeholders. RESEARCH

The UCLA Latino Policy & Politics Initiative and Alianza for Youth Justice have released a report: The Latinx Data Gap in the Youth Justice System, which examines how data is collected on Latinx youth in the youth justice system, finding widespread inconsistencies and inaccuracies, as well as a nationwide under count in the number of Latinx youth held in secure confinement.
